

Fraud Alert:

A new phishing scam for debit card information has recently emerged in Georgia.

Credit Union members are being contacted by phone and asked to call a phone number NOT affiliated with the Credit Union and provide detailed card information. The calls prompt members to call a phone number and “verify account information” in order to “reactivate your card.” The call suggests that the card has been suspended and the account frozen and unless action is taken the card cannot be used.

These calls are not coming from GEMC Federal Credit Union or any of our affiliated partners.

GEMC Federal Credit Union will never ask you to provide secure account information via phone, text, or e-mail.

If you are suspicious of any request for personal account information, call the Credit Union immediately.

Also, if you *did* respond to such a solicitation, you should contact us immediately.
